Terraflake Cleaning & Maintenance Recommendations



DESCRIPTION:

Most conventional floor cleaning materials are suitable for use on the allnex Terraflake floor coating system.

Preferably a neutral pH sanitizer / detergent are recommended to ensure the long lasting durable properties of the products. The following cleaner has been found to be suitable for use and is readily available to your Cleaning Firm.

CLEANING TEMPERATURES:

CLEANING:

Manual Cleaning:

1. Sweep and /or vacuum up dust and debris.
2. Apply using a mop and bucket; with the detergent diluted to manufacturer's recommendations.
3. Leave on floor for approximately five minutes.
4. If and when required scrub the floor with a deck scrubber (This step is generally only required on surfaces containing non- slip media or if there is a build -up of dirt on the surface that cannot be removed with the conventional mop system.)
5. Wet vacuum or mop residue.
6. Thoroughly rinse with warm clean water to ensure that the surface PH of the floor is neutral (PH7).
7. Allow surface to dry before re-use.

MAINTENANCE:

To prolong the life of the allnex Terraflake, the use of dirt traps in doorways to eliminate grit which may scratch the floor is a good idea. Inspect for damage regularly.

****Note****

Do not seal or polish floor coatings.

Do not use cleaning detergents containing pine oil.

Remove heavy soiling immediately.

Use clean warm water for rinsing, replace water regularly.

Dirty equipment; particularly dirty mops do not clean they merely redistribute the dirt.

When scrubbing use nylon brushes or blue pads only.

Care must be taken not to scratch the surface.

SUBSEQUENT RECOATING:

Note

The information below is a guideline and in all instances the allnex technical literature with regard to the specific glaze coat option must be referred to.

Terraflake – With Aquaglaze UV Topcoat system.

This product may be refinished at any stage.

1. Clean thoroughly.
2. Sand with 120 grit paper.
3. Remove dust.
5. Apply Aquaglaze UV Glaze
6. When dry, (Once water has completely evaporated) Apply second coat of Aquaglaze UV Glaze

Terraflake – With Rapidcote Clear Topcoat system.

This product may be refinished at any stage.

1. Clean thoroughly.
2. Sand with 120 grit paper.
3. Remove dust.
4. Apply Rapidcote Clear
5. After a minimum of 1 hour, (or longer if conditions are relevant) apply a second coat of Rapidcote Clear.

Terraflake – With Revathane Glaze Topcoat system.

This product may be refinished at any stage.

1. Clean thoroughly.
2. Sand with 120 grit paper.
3. Remove dust.
4. Apply Reglaze Etch - Allow Reglaze Etch to dry.
5. Apply Revathane Glaze (within 1 hour of Etch).
6. After an overnight cure, apply a second coat of Revathane.
